PPM Planning Information

- In doing a PPM, you may elect any method to use - container company, full-service company, rent a truck, or any combination of those or in your own vehicles.
- You do need to set up your move on DPS.
- Authorized operating expenses to count towards lowering the taxable amount of your incentive pay must be dated on or after the date of your orders. Anything dated prior to the orders date will not be included.
- The incentive pay is taxed at 22%
- The estimate is just the estimate.
- You are not reimbursed \$ per \$. You are paid based on the weight and distance that you move up to your weight allotment. It is calculated at 100% of the governments constructive cost of what they would pay a moving company to move the same weight and distance. There may be additional fees you could receive such as fuel surcharges, bulky items, or multiple pickups if approved.
- There are no weight deductions in a PPM. All pro-gear and packing material count towards your weight.
- You do need empty and full weight tickets for each mode of transportation utilized (POVs, rental truck, container, etc.)
- You may request up to 60% of your incentive pay up front.
